EMS Lieutenant

The Highland County Department of Emergency Medical Services, located in Monterey Virginia, is announcing an employment opportunity for the position of full-time EMS Lieutenant to respond to emergency medical calls and working together with other career and volunteer staff in our combination system. They will coordinate EMS Training in County for career and volunteer members as well as initial certification classes. This position will be a 24/48-hour schedule or as needed for staffing.

All applicants will be subject to a background screening in accordance with Virginia Office of EMS regulations and will need to provide a copy of their DMV driving record.

Pay range of \$48,000 - \$52,000. If accepted, applicants will be eligible to receive county benefits which include health, vision, and dental benefits. This position is eligible for the Virginia Retirement System (VRS).
